

## DEMOCRATIC EDUCATION PROPOSAL

### HB 1843

- \$3,100 more per student
- Increased funding for Learning Assistance Programs, Bilingual Instructional & Highly Capable
- Increased funding for career and technical education
- Increased funding for counselors



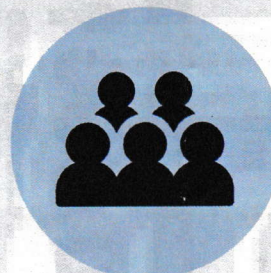
### STUDENTS

- Starting teacher salary: \$45,500
- 10% salary increase after 3 years
- Keeps National Board bonus
- Includes cost-of-living raises
- Ten professional development days
- Market based salaries for all staff
- Provides regional adjustments



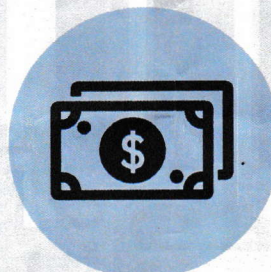
### TEACHERS

- Levy lid capped at 24% by 2021
- Eliminates grandfathered (higher) levy lids by 2021

- Capital gains loophole closure
- Corporate tax loophole closures
- Carbon pricing

## REPUBLICAN EDUCATION PROPOSAL

### SSB 5607

- \$1,100 more per student
- Eliminates small-class size initiative
- Redefines what "low-income" is, taking away help for 300,000 kids from struggling families.

- Starting teacher salary: \$45,000
- Allows use of uncertified teachers
- Cuts National Board bonus
- No professional development days
- Teacher strikes prohibited
- Eliminates cost-of-living raises
- Provides regional adjustments

- Local levies are eliminated in 2019
- Starting in 2020, districts can raise up to 10% local levies
- No levy equalization or taxpayer relief for low assessed value districts.

- Levy swap which would raise property taxes dramatically in Seattle and other "property-rich" districts and use most of the money to lower property tax rates in "property-poor" districts.

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
